
Easingwold District Community Care Association (EDCCA) is a registered charity which seeks to improve the quality of life in the local community and help those in need.

The Easingwold District Community Minibus

The 15 seater Minibus has been generously funded by North Yorkshire County Council, Hambleton District Council and Easingwold Town Council and is available for hire by Voluntary and Community groups as well as schools.

The Minibus can accommodate a wheelchair and has a lift to help with access.

EDCCA runs weekly assisted trips to destinations including Clifton Moor, Thirsk, Helmsley Northallerton and Ripon.

All our volunteer drivers undertake a rigorous training course including health and safety instruction.

Can I volunteer?

To volunteer to drive the minibus bus you must be under 70 years old and register as a volunteer with EDCCA. You also must undertake MIDAS training which EDCCA will organise and pay for. We also need Driver Assistants to accompany the passengers and help them on and off the bus.
