#### Telephone Befriending

#### Meals on Wheels

The meals service supplies a freshly cooked, nutritious, hot two course meal, delivered by a team of friendly volunteers. This service is currently offered to those living in Easingwold and the surrounding villages.

#### Community Car Scheme

to help people who have difficulty using public transport or who need to travel when there is no public transport available. The Scheme is supported by volunteers using their own cars who are paid a mileage allowance. Passengers are charged a contribution towards the drivers' expenses.

### Knit and Natter

meets on the first Monday of every month (except Bank Holidays) 1.30-3.30pm at Springhill Court, Manor Road, Easingwold.



meets every Monday 10.30-12.30pm at the Police House, Easingwold.

## Sitting Service

Volunteers visit carers in their own home and provide them with the opportunity to have a



break, visiting their friends, having a trip out or going to a medical appointment. The volunteer sits with the person being cared for. There is no personal care involved. Visits are normally weekly or fortnightly and last a couple of hours at a time to suit both the volunteer and the person being visited. Volunteers are paid travelling expenses and training and support is provided.

#### Easingwold Community Minibus

EDCCA run regular trips out to various destinations. The bus is available for hire to community and voluntary groups.

#### Food Bank

We deliver to Easingwold and our many surrounding villages. If you wish, we can discuss further help and offer confidential support over the telephone. Our food packages contain tinned and dry goods for 3-5 days supply. We include UHT milk, bread and spread as well as toiletries. We can also try to supply fresh fruit and vegetables.

EDCCA also provides information on a wide range of local services and health and welfare matters and sign-posting to specialist agencies if required. We provide a short term Wheelchair Hire Service.
